nizations and volunteers worked tirelessly to make this event a success.

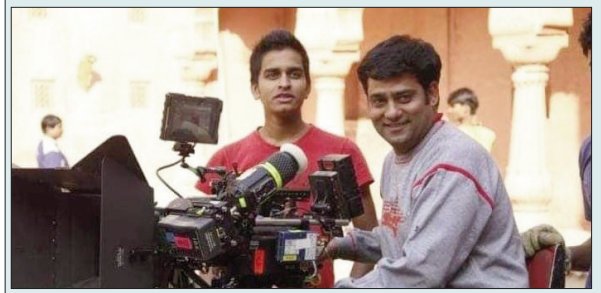

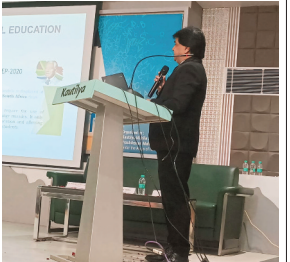
Priyanka Chauhan Earns Ph.D. Degree

Udaipur: Priyanka Chauhan, a research scholar at BN College of Pharmacy, Udaipur, has been awarded a Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) degree by BN University for her groundbreaking work on the topic, "Formulation and Optimization of PLGA-Encapsulated Metformin Hydrochloride Microspheres." Her research was conducted under the expert guidance of Dr. Chetan Singh Chauhan, Professor of Pharmaceutics.

The study focuses on the development of a novel drug delivery system using poly(lactic-co-glycolic acid) (PLGA) microspheres to encapsulate Metformin Hydrochloride, a widely used antidiabetic drug. This advanced formulation is designed to maintain blood sugar levels in diabetic patients over an extended period, thereby reducing the frequency of medication intake. Additionally, the formulation aims to alleviate complications commonly associated with diabetes, including cardiovascular, renal, and ophthalmological issues. Priyanka Chauhan has actively presented and published her research findings in various national and international seminars and journals. Her work demonstrates significant potential to enhance patient compliance and improve the quality of life for individuals managing diabetes. Hailing from the village of Mataji Ka Kheda near Nadol in Pali district, Priyanka's achievement has brought pride to her community. The announcement was made by Dr. Kamal Singh Rathore, the Public Relations Officer of BN University, who commended her innovative contributions to pharmaceutical sciences. This research highlights the possibilities of integrating advanced polymer-based drug delivery systems in modern therapeutics, offering a sustainable and efficient approach to managing chronic conditions like diabetes.

Deputy CM Diyakumari's Initiative Leads to Approval from Union Minister Nitin Gadkari



Udaipur: The state government, under the leadership of Chief Minister Shri Bhajanlal Sharma, has been consistently working to strengthen transportation facilities in the state. Recently, Deputy Chief Minister

Diyakumari met with Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways, Nitin Gadkari, to seek support for the development of various roads and new large-scale projects in the state. Following this meeting, the Union Ministry of Road

Transport and Highways has approved an allocation of Rs. 1154.47 crore.

The approved funds include the development of the Nandeshwar-Gogunda road in Udaipur district. Under the Central Road and Infrastructure Fund (CRIF), and the Setu Bandhan Scheme, the central government has approved the widening and strengthening of 748.80 km of state roads, along with the construction of a high-level bridge over the Kalisindh River in Kota.

As part of this initiative, Rs. 65.25 crore has been sanc-

tioned for the strengthening of a 39-kilometer-long road in Udaipur district, connecting Gogunda-Majawda-Ubeshwar-Dhar-Rampura-Sisarama-Nayakhera-Nandeshwar to National Highway 58E. Deputy Chief Minister Diyakumari expressed her gratitude to Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi and Union Minister Nitin Gadkari for this approval.
