#### Integrated Policy for Skill Development Urged by MP Mannalal Rawat

He pointed out critical challenges, such as the lack of coordination among 20 ministries involved in skill programs, a shortage of qualified trainers, regional imbalances in demand and supply, and inadequate inclusion of women in training programs.

Rawat further stressed the need for integration between higher education, vocational training, and entrepreneurial education while addressing the lack of access to financing and career guidance.

Through the Speaker, he urged the government to implement a unified strategy under NEP 2020 to address these issues comprehensively, ensuring India's youth are equipped with employment-oriented skills and entrepreneurship capabilities to meet the demands of a dynamic economy.

## Honour Run Unites Jaipur Citizens


