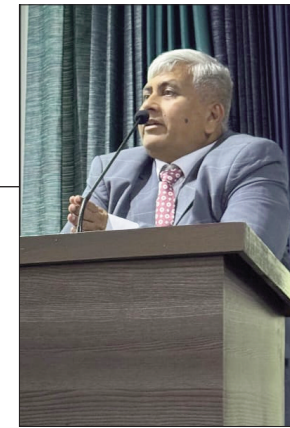
A session on "The Importance of Spirituality in
