NEET Exam on May 4, Online Applications Begin

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has commenced the application process for NEET UG 2025, India's premier medical entrance examination. The exam is scheduled for May 4, 2025, in a single session from 2:00 PM to 5:00 PM, conducted in pen-and-paper mode. Aspiring candidates can submit their applications via the official NTA website until March 7, 2025.

Eligibility and Courses:

NEET UG is mandatory for admission into undergraduate medical programs such as MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, BYMS, BSMS, Military Nursing Services BSc, and four-year nursing courses. Candidates must be at least 17 years old by December 31 of the admission year; there is no upper age limit.

Application Fees:

- General category: ₹1,700
- EWS & OBC: ₹1,600
- SC, ST, PWD: ₹1,000
- Foreign applicants: ₹9,500

Exam Pattern:

The 3-hour exam comprises 180 questions: 45 each from Physics and Chemistry, and 90 from Biology (Botany and Zoology), totaling 720 marks. Each correct answer awards 4 marks, while 1 mark is deducted for incorrect responses.

- Application Correction Period: March 9 – 11, 2025

- Result Declaration: June 14, 2025

The exam will be available in 13 languages, including English, Hindi, Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu. Indian citizens and Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) aiming to study medicine abroad must qualify NEET UG for eligibility in India's licensing process. Modern Medical Success: Vision Restored at Geetanjali

Hospital, Udaipur, achieved a significant medical milestone by restoring the eyesight of a 10-year-old patient.

Under the leadership of Dr. Rini Sukhwai, an expert in retina and ophthalmic disorders, and Dr. Rahul Sahlot, a specialist in hormones and diabetes, a team comprising

Dr. Geetika, Dr. Renu, Dr. Rishabh, Dr. Pranjal, and Dr. Kalpesh successfully performed this complex surgery. The patient was suffering from Type-1 Diabetes Mellitus, with blood sugar levels reaching 650 mg/dl and an HBA1c level of 15%, leading to complete vision loss in her right eye. Given the severity of her condition, she was immediately admitted to Geetanjali Hospital,

where intensive care was provided for five days to stabilize her blood sugar levels. Once her condition was stable, a complex vitreo-retinal surgery and intraocular lens (IOL) implantation were performed by vitreo-retinal surgeon Dr. Rini Sukhwai. Following the successful surgery at Geetanjali Medical College and Hospital, the patient's vision remarkably improved

to 6/9 the very next day. This achievement is a testament to the expertise and dedication of the doctors and highlights that advanced medical treatments at Geetanjali Hospital make effective recovery from severe conditions possible.

of the students and provide them with an opportunity to express their emotions through art. On this occasion, Mr. I. Gopal Mather, CMD of Pidilite Industries, was also present.

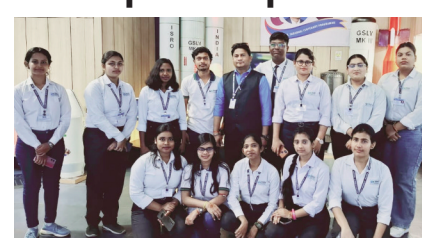
