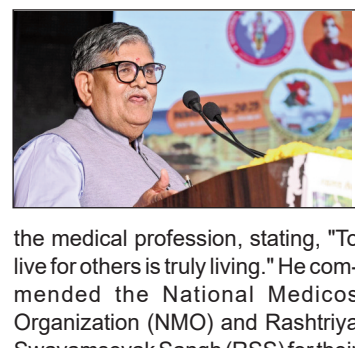
44th National Medicos Organization (NMO) Convention Concludes with a Strong Call for Service-Oriented Healthcare



Udaipur: The 44th National Convention of the National Medicos Organization (NMO) concluded at Gattani Hall, RNT Medical College, with a resounding message emphasizing the spirit of service in the medical profession. The event witnessed the participation of eminent dignitaries, including Punjab Governor Gulabchand Kataria, Rajasthan Governor Vagde, and Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla, who stressed that medical service should never be treated as a business but as a noble commitment to humanity.

Governor Kataria Advocates for Compassion in Medical Services

Punjab Governor Gulabchand Kataria, in his keynote address, underscored the selfless nature of



the medical profession, stating, "To live for others is truly living." He commended the National Medicos Organization (NMO) and Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) for their combined efforts in extending healthcare to remote and tribal regions through initiatives like Vanvasi Kalyan Ashram. A Tribute to Dr. Mahendra Bhanawat: A Stalwart of Folk Arts

The passing of Dr. Mahendra Bhanawat is an immense loss to the world of folk literature and Rajasthan's cultural heritage. His relentless efforts in preserving, documenting, and promoting Rajasthan's folk traditions have left an everlasting impact.

For over four decades, I had the privilege of knowing him closely and engaging in numerous discussions on literature, culture, and historical documentation. His association with Bhartiya Lok Kala Mandal was instrumental in shaping the study of folk arts, and he stood firm during challenging times, particularly when controversies arose regarding the institution. His unwavering support for the preservation of its core values and mission was truly commendable.

Dr. Bhanawat's literary journey was extraordinary. As a scholar, he authored over 100 books and 10,000 literary works, contributing significantly to folk theatre, oral traditions, and Rajasthan heritage. His book "Nirbhay Meera" provided unique insights into Meera Bai's life, and his pioneering research on Lamkri Natya, for which he earned his Ph.D. in 1968, remains a landmark study in folk theatre.

Beyond literature, our discussions often revolved around the documentation of historical events, including our shared work on the Priyadarshini All India Football Tournament journal, where his meticulous research added immense value. His ability to bridge history with contemporary cultural discourse made him a guiding light for many scholars and researchers.

His final journey was marked by a poignant moment that reflected his progressive ideals—his daughters and daughters-in-law, alongside his son and grandsons, carried his bier, defying age-old customs. His departure is a profound loss, not just personally but to the entire literary and cultural landscape of Rajasthan. May his soul rest in peace, and may his invaluable contributions continue to inspire generations to come.
